

A meeting of the Council for the City of Crystal Falls was held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall on Monday, December 14, 2015 at 5:30 P.M. Central Time.

Roll Call: Mayor Sommers, Councilors Sherby, Schiavo, McCarthy and Hagglund.

Mayor Sommers led the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: Jeff Bal and Chris Willman representing the Crystella Recreation Association gave a presentation on the renovations made at the ski hill.

Mayor Sommers reported on the events of the DDA meeting earlier in the day.

Councilor Sherby supported by Councilor McCarthy moved to reappoint Michael Ferguson and Gary Hough to the DDA effective December 1, 2015. Terms to expire on November 30, 2019.

The Crystal View parking lot retaining wall issue was discussed.

Councilor Schiavo supported by Councilor McCarthy moved to approve the Asset Purchase Agreement for the transfer of ownership of the CATV system and authorize it to be signed with the understanding that Packerland Broadband will comply with the requirements of the pole attachment agreement while making upgrades to the system

prior to the transfer of ownership.

The City's CATV rates will not increase for 2016.

Councilor Sherby supported by Councilor McCarthy moved to endorse the suspension of winter burials once the ground is frozen or snow plowing is required to access the designated gravesite. Winter burial rates will be reduced to \$200 (vault) and \$50 (ashes) and the winter burial date will be changed to November 1st.
