

CRYSTAL FALLS TOWNSHIP GENERAL ELECTION MILLAGE REQUEST

On Tuesday, November 2, 2010, the Taxpayers of Crystal Falls Township will be asked to vote on a 3.5 millage request for general operations for the years 2011 through 2014. The millage is expected to raise \$ 315,965.00 in the first year.

The ballot language is required by law to be phrased as an increase in millage as the present authorized general operations millage of 4 mills will expire at the end of 2010. The millage proposal now before the voters is for a reduced future millage rate.
